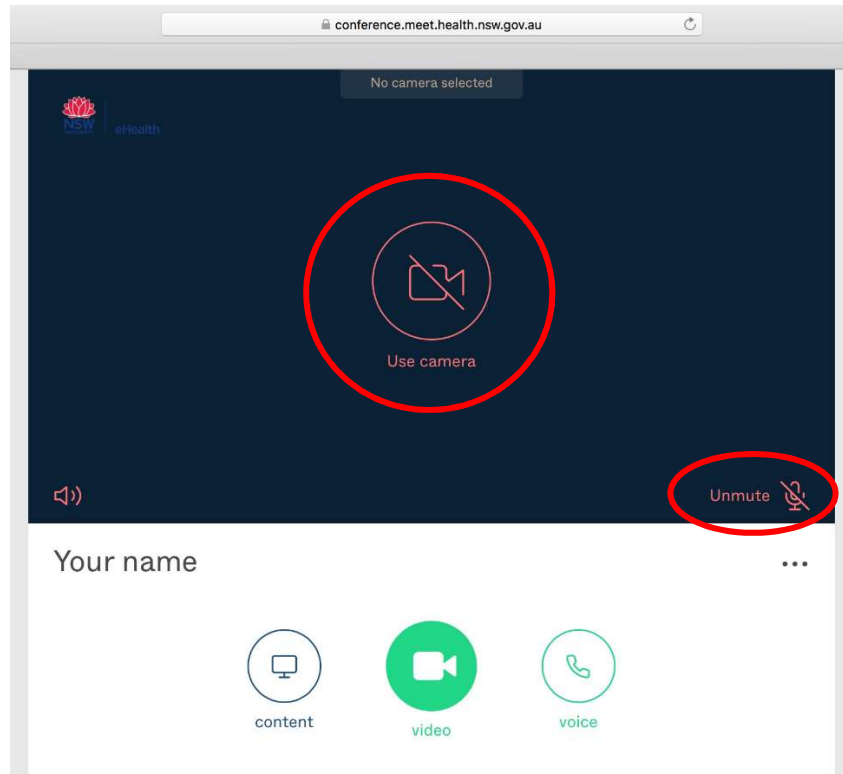
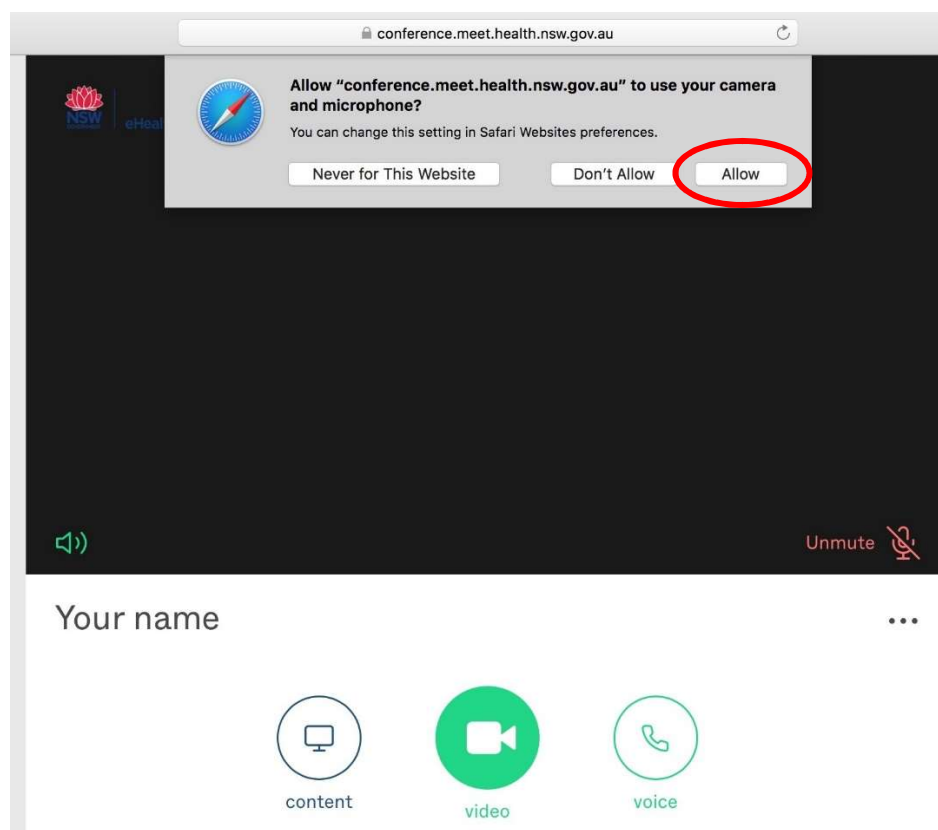


Checking camera and microphone permissions in Apple Safari on Mac:

- If prompted, click “Allow” when a Safari pop-up asks for permission to use the camera and microphone
- You may need to try and activate the camera and microphone in order to be asked for permission. To do this, click the “Use camera” icon in the centre of the screen, and the “Unmute” icon in the bottom right of the screen:



- After you do this, you will likely be asked for permission to access the camera and microphone. Select “Allow” when the pop-up appears:



- Once the camera and microphone have been activated, you will see a small red video icon to the right of the web address bar. If you select this, you can change the permissions for these elements – and can select the “Always Allow” option to bypass these steps on future conferences:
